Keynote speakers from Austria, Germany, UK, Romania, Poland, Hungary, and the Czech Republic will share their expertise and recent research projects in Hallyu studies together with invited graduate students and practitioners.

The organizers welcome graduate students of any fields of social studies and humanities to present their papers that address the theme of Korean Wave in Europe, including, but not limited to the following:
